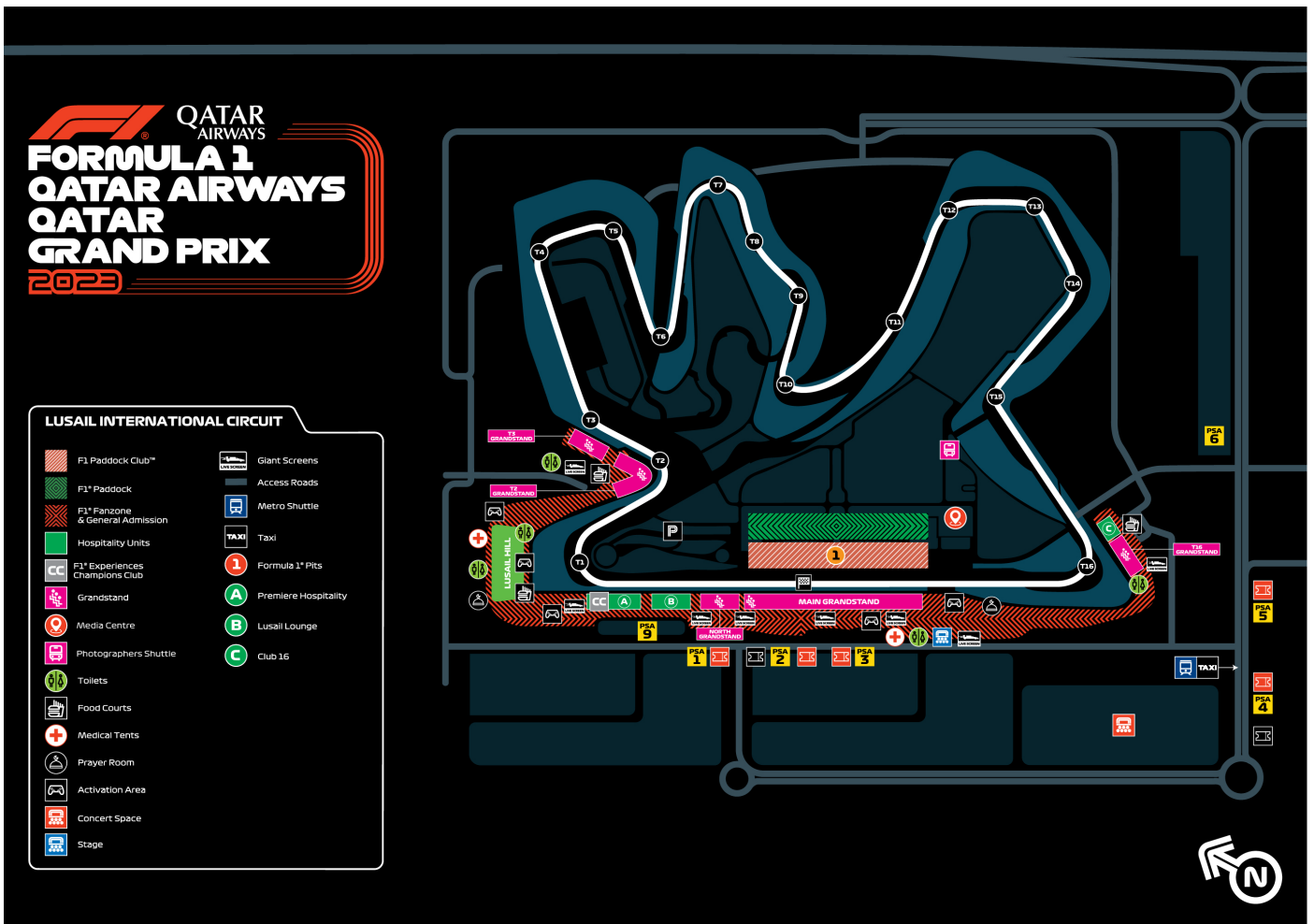

The FORMULA 1 QATAR AIRWAYS QATAR GRAND PRIX 2023 is a vibrant festival of speed and entertainment that celebrates a long-standing passion across the Middle East, for automobiles and racing. The 2023 championship is the first in a long-term contract and partnership with FORMULA 1. Qatar hosted its debut F1 race in 2021 and will continue to host the event for ten years from this year.

The FORMULA 1 QATAR AIRWAYS QATAR GRAND PRIX 2023 promises an unforgettable experience for fans and true motorsports followers to enjoy a fun-filled weekend in Qatar with their loved ones, as it will be the only race in the season to enjoy a carefully designed circuit to enable frequent wheel-on-wheel competition and overtaking for the most action packed race experience possible.

LUSAIL INTERNATIONAL CIRCUIT

Lusail International Circuit (LIC) is a premier motorsport entertainment destination in Qatar that combines a world-class FIA Grade 1 and FIM Grand A circuit, bespoke hospitality lounges, and state-of-the-art facilities to support various action-packed international and local motorsport events.

Hosting the only Middle Eastern round of the MotoGP World Championship since 2004 following the construction of the circuit, LIC has steadily grown its portfolio of major international motorsports events and, in November 2021, welcomed the FORMULA 1 QATAR AIRWAYS QATAR GRAND PRIX 2023 to Doha as part of a ten-year commitment to hold the race in Qatar until 2032. More recently, LIC announced that the World Endurance Championship (WEC) will debut in Qatar as "Qatar 1812" from 2024 to 2029, meaning that all three pinnacle global motorsport events will now occur at the circuit.



RENOVATED CIRCUIT

The popular circuit layout has been retained but the facilities have been rebuilt to improve and enhance the experience for all racegoers, with bigger team garages to accommodate all F1 requirements, five-star VIP Areas, a larger fan zone for the public, and a renovated permanent grandstand with larger capacity. LIC has also introduced Lusail Hill at Turn 1, which is a dedicated elevated viewing area at the end of Turn 1 which aims to provide more variety across the circuit and deliver a seamless racing experience for spectators.

The circuit renovations and upgrades expanded the seating and parking capacity, delivering a world-class state-of-the-art experience to spectators and drivers, ensure conformity with the FIA & FIM technical standards and bring in advanced technologies to enhance the venue capabilities.

Vehicle Access. Media with car passes have a designated parking at the circuit, P1.

Option 1. MAC to LIC (BUS MALL) Media can choose to take the free shuttle bus from Media Accreditation Center at DEC, and will be dropped at the Bus Mall location at the circuit.

Option 2. Karwa App We highly recommend using the Karwa App for transportation. With this option, you will be dropped directly at the circuit, at designated drop-off points, ensuring a hassle-free and swift journey.

Option 3. Uber + Shuttle Bus Alternatively, you can choose to use Uber services. When using Uber, you will be dropped off at the QNB Metro Station, which is a convenient location nearby. From there, we have organized free shuttle buses to transport you directly to the circuit. These shuttle buses will be available at regular intervals.

NOTE. At the entrance to the circuit, you will need to show your accreditation and go through security check, from there, a shuttle can take you a short distance to the Media Center

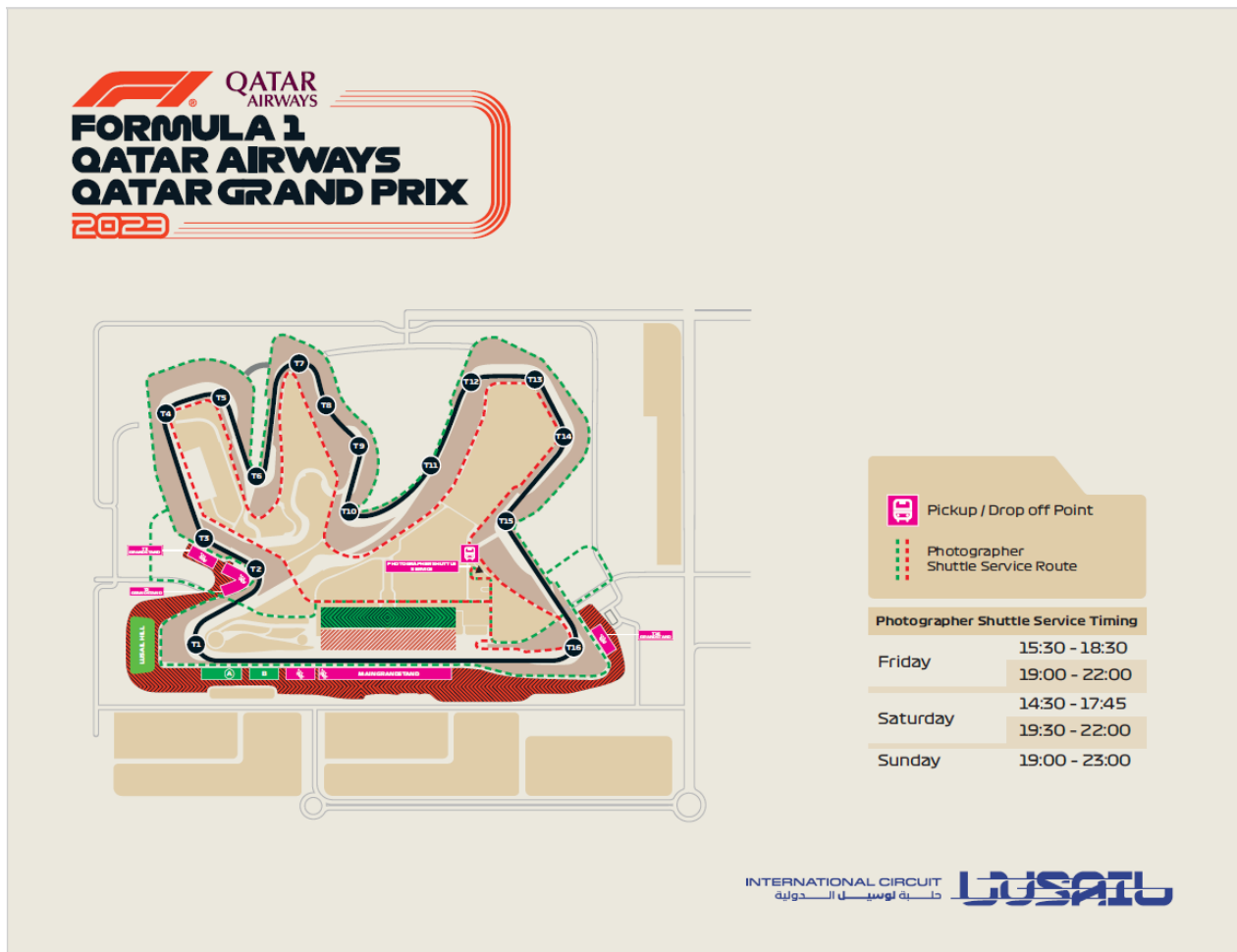
