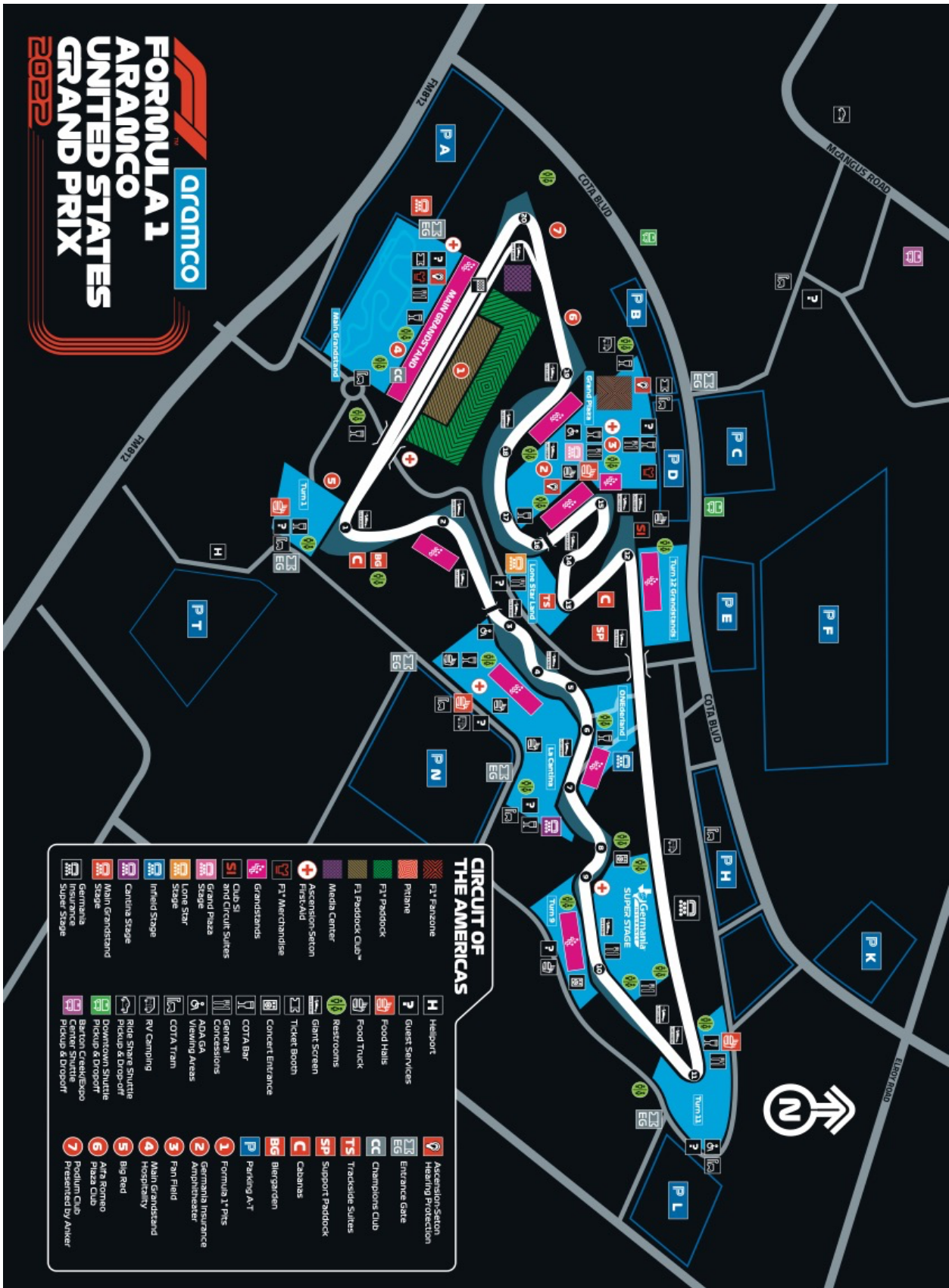

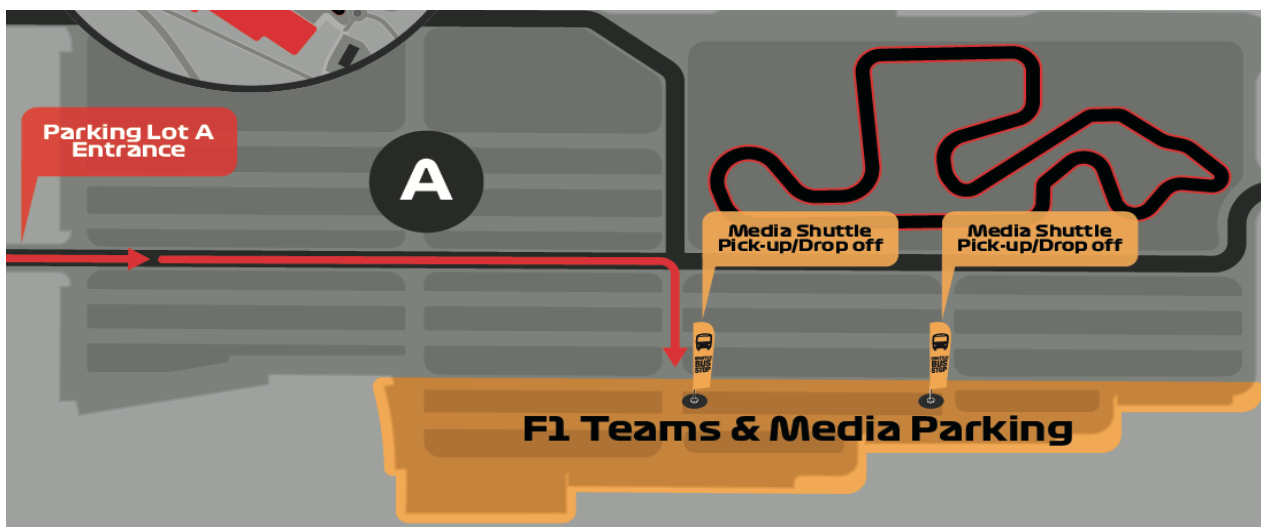




ROUTE TO ACCREDITATION CENTER & CIRCUIT OF THE AMERICAS

PLEASE NOTE: All media must always adhere to the FIA's Code of Conduct during the event. To pick up credentials, media guests must have electronically signed the Formula 1 Accreditation Waiver prior to arrival.

Media Accreditation Center (MAC) Address:	7736 Kellam Road Del Valle, TX 78617 (Located in Lot R at intersection of Kellam & Elroy)
From Downtown Austin to the MAC:	Follow I-35 S/US-290 W and TX-71 E to Garfield. Exit and turn right down Kellam Road. The Media Accreditation Center will be on your left.
Distance from Austin Airport:	Distance to Circuit of The Americas from Austin-Bergstrom International Airport is 10 miles. Travel TX 71 or 45/130 Toll Road.
Once you have received your parking pass:	Circuit of The Americas (COTA) is located 15 miles southeast of downtown Austin and connected to the downtown area via TX-71, US-183 and the 45/130 toll road. From downtown Austin, take I-35 South to TX-71 East. Exit TX-71 at Burleson Road and continue until Highway 183. Go south on Highway 183 and make a left on FM 812. After passing beneath the 45/130 toll road, COTA will be on the left.
MAC to Lot A Parking:	Once you've received your credentials and parking pass, follow the "MEDIA PARKING" directional signage down COTA Boulevard to parking Lot A.





WELCOME TO CIRCUIT OF THE AMERICAS

Circuit of The Americas is THE premier destination for world-class motorsports and entertainment in the United States. Set on 1,200 acres in the rolling hills just outside downtown Austin, Circuit of The Americas has hosted the biggest names in racing, sports, music and even movies and television since 2012. At its heart is a 3.41-mile racetrack that was designed to challenge the world's most exacting competitors while providing a thrilling spectacle for audiences. The facility is truly a multi-purpose venue for unparalleled experiences.

The 20-turn, counter-clockwise circuit takes advantage of the naturally undulating landscape, including an intimidating 133-foot hill at Turn 1. Circuit of The Americas is the home of the Formula 1 United States Grand Prix, and has been for a decade now, and is home to the only MotoGP race in the country – the Red Bull Grand Prix of The Americas. In addition, the Circuit currently hosts NASCAR, and has previously hosted ESPN's X Games, INDYCAR, the FIA World Endurance Championship, IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship, Pirelli World Challenge and more.

Nestled within the track is Germania Insurance Amphitheater, one of the largest outdoor amphitheaters in Central Texas with a seating capacity of 13,000 people. This unique treasure in the Live Music Capital of the World has hosted some of the biggest names in music and entertainment, including Texas icon Willie Nelson, Jimmy Buffett, KISS, Nine Inch Nails, Kanye West, Kenny Chesney, Drake, Maroon 5, Muse, One Republic, Kelly Clarkson, Odesza and more. When the Circuit needs to make room for a festival-like music experience, the Germania Insurance Super Stage takes performances to a new level. The Super Stage lawn has a capacity of 83,000 and has provided dancing room for fans to enjoy superstars such as Taylor Swift, Billy Joel, Metallica, Bruno Mars, Elton John, P!NK, Justin Timberlake, and many more. The Circuit also boasts the iconic 251-foot observation tower, attached to the amphitheater and at the center of the track, a 6,000-seat USL Championship soccer and multi-purpose stadium, a one-mile high-speed karting track, a 12-story starting grid view zip line ride and provides on-site premium RV park with 78 spaces and year-round operations.

Today, Circuit of The Americas has generated in excess of \$8 billion of economic impact to Central Texas through increased tourism and annual operations. The Circuit also continues to be a leader in environmental awareness and sustainability and has helped make advances in educational and scientific fields, including solar car technology, as well as racing and consumer automotive technology. If using Rideshare on Friday, Saturday or Sunday:

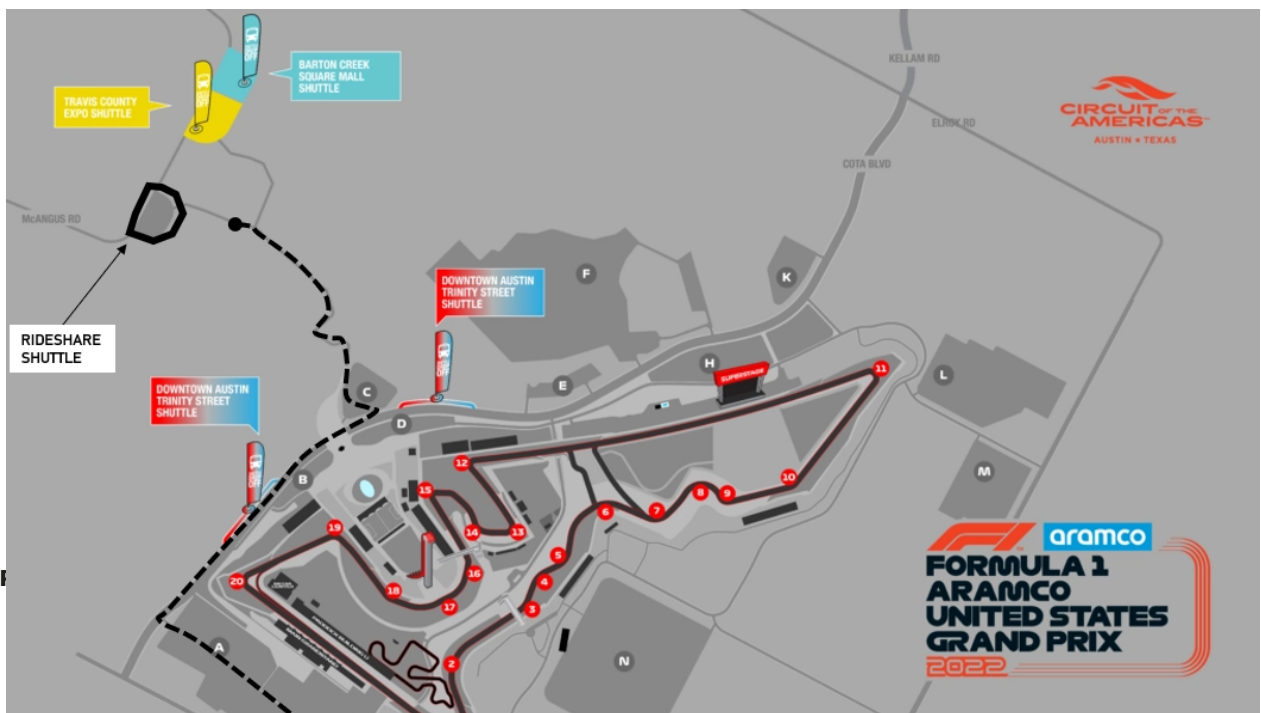

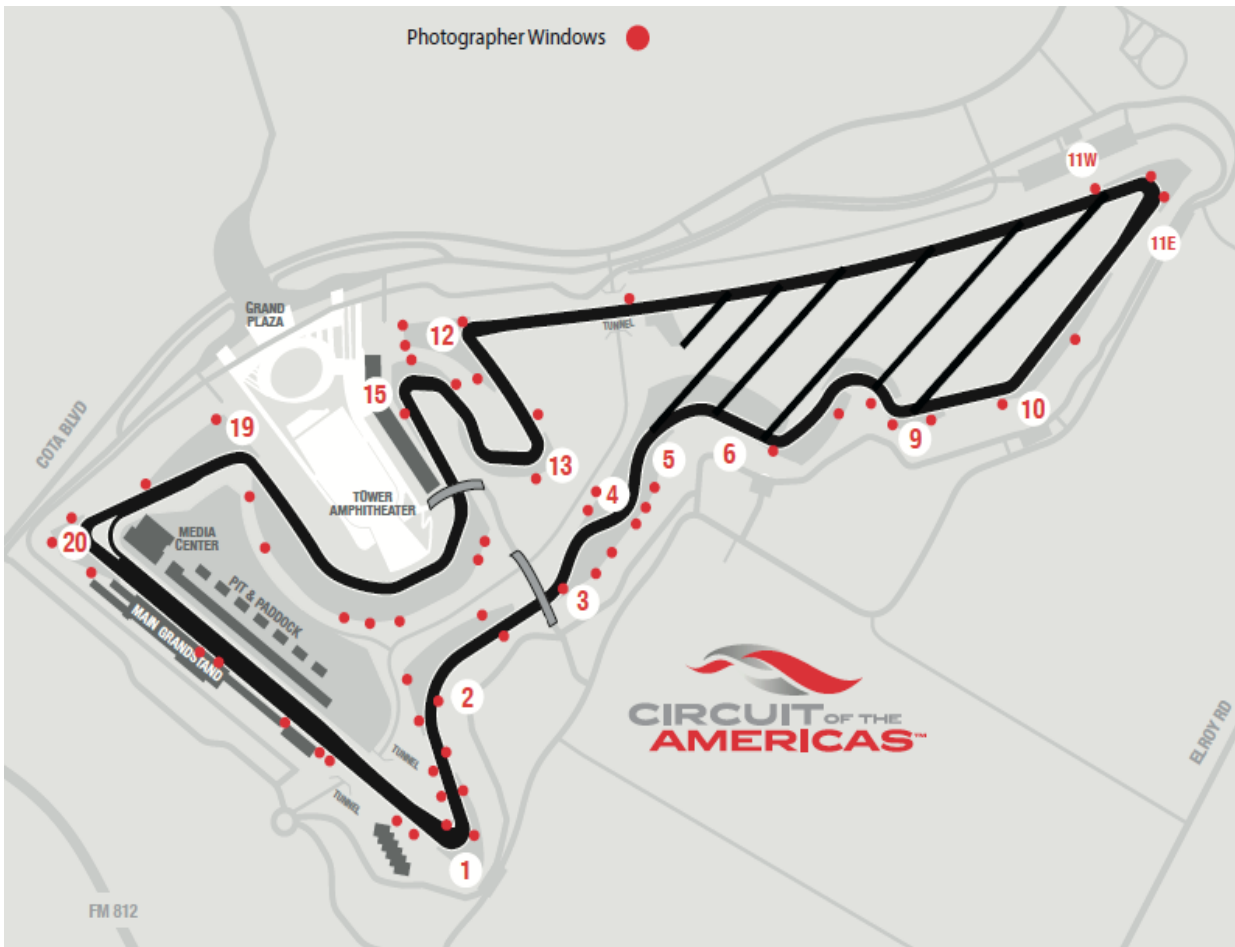
