BRAZIL ON THE GRID AT THE SÃO PAULO F1 GRAND PRIX

The presence of a Brazilian driver on the grid at the F1 GP São Paulo, Gabriel Bortoleto, is one of the main highlights of next weekend's race. The last time a Brazilian driver competed in the F1 grid at Interlagos was in 2017, with Felipe Massa. The close battle between McLaren teammates Lando Norris and Oscar Piastri, separated by just one point and chased by Max Verstappen, also fuels excitement among fans. Adding to the buzz is the presence of Lewis Hamilton, an honorary Brazilian citizen, now racing for Ferrari, a team with a huge following in Brazil.

Bortoleto, F3 champion in 2023 and F2 champion in 2024, drives for Sauber (which will become Audi next year) and has been regarded as one of the season's biggest revelations. The young driver will have a passionate home crowd cheering him on during both the sprint race and the Grand Prix.

At the 2017 race, in his farewell to Formula 1 at Interlagos, Felipe Massa, racing for Williams, started 10th and finished 7th, receiving a heartfelt ovation from the Brazilian fans.

The Formula 1 MSC Cruises Grande Prêmio de São Paulo 2025 will feature a sprint race for the fifth consecutive year. With 33 points up for grabs, the weekend could be decisive in the Drivers' Championship. The Constructors' title has already been secured by McLaren. For the first time, the top three finishers and the winning team will receive a trophy commissioned by the race promoter, rather than the event sponsor. The design was created by a local studio, with the finishing touches by Alan Mosca, son of Sid Mosca, who painted helmets for several Brazilian drivers, including Ayrton Senna.

The F1 GP São Paulo will also feature the Fanzone for the second consecutive year, following its success last year. This time, Thiaguinho, Seu Jorge, and the duo Matheus & Kauan will perform, among other attractions. Thiaguinho will also perform the Brazilian National Anthem before the start of the race. The interaction between fans, drivers, and team principals is eagerly anticipated. The event promoters continue to invest heavily in entertainment, one of the key reasons for the steady growth in attendance since 2021.

This will be the 43rd Formula 1 race held at Interlagos. The family of José Carlos Pace, after whom the circuit is named, will be honored during the event. Fifty years ago, at Interlagos, racing for Brabham, Pace achieved the only victory of his career. The driver tragically died in a plane crash in 1977.

Brazilian motorsport will also be represented during the São Paulo F1 Grand Prix weekend by the Porsche Cup and Formula 4 races

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TRAFFIC SYSTEM FROM FRIDAY TO SUNDAY

On the days of the F1 GP São Paulo, it is easy and quick to reach the Interlagos Circuit, thanks to the traffic system designed by GPSP in partnership with the traffic police.

Arrival at the Interlagos Circuit:

a. Starting on FRIDAY, traffic will be modified and there will be an exclusive lane for accredited vehicles. Avenida Interlagos, the main road leading to the circuit, will have a reversible lane for access to Gate 7. The entire route will be signposted by the traffic police and GP São Paulo, with support from the Military Police.

b. There will be an access control point where it will be necessary to lower the vehicle windows, and each occupant must present their credential. ONLY accredited vehicles and accredited people will be allowed to pass.

c. Upon entering through Gate 7, follow the signs to the parking area indicated by the circuit staff.

Departure from the Interlagos Circuit:

a. On GP days, the traffic circulation system around the circuit will be modified and signposted for event-exclusive traffic flow. Accredited persons must follow the route indicated by the traffic police.

b. Exit from the circuit will be through Gate J or Gate Z, as indicated by the circuit staff.

c. All gates and routes will be clearly marked by the traffic control team. Upon leaving the circuit, the indicated routes will be supported by the traffic police and the Military Police.

d. The gates will remain open throughout the event.

Drive slowly and carefully, especially in the exclusive lane for accredited vehicles. It is NOT a high-speed lane, and there will be pedestrian crossings.

Arrival and Departure by Taxi and Uber:

Taxis are authorized to go as far as Moscow Square.

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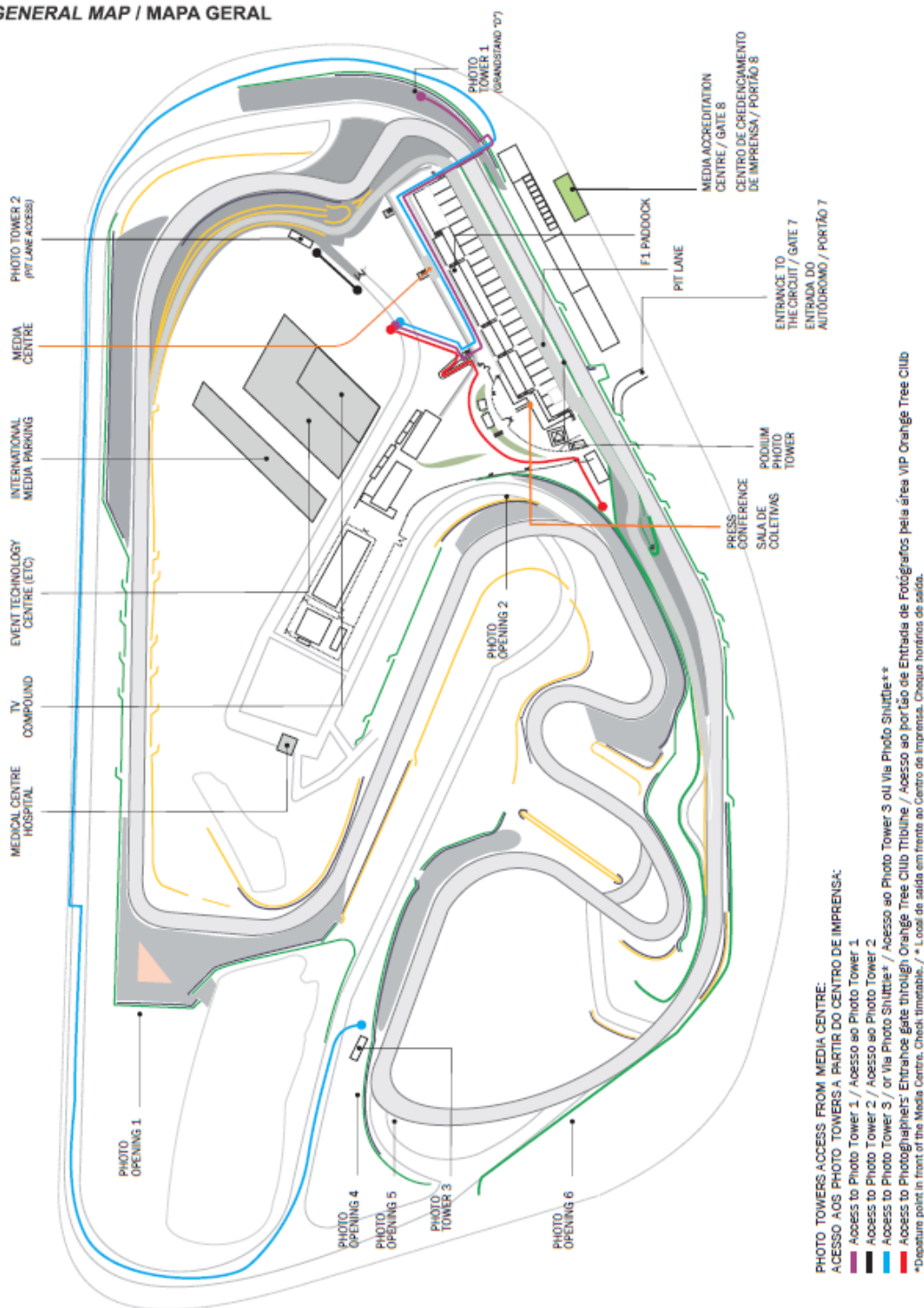

GENERAL MAP / MAPA GERAL



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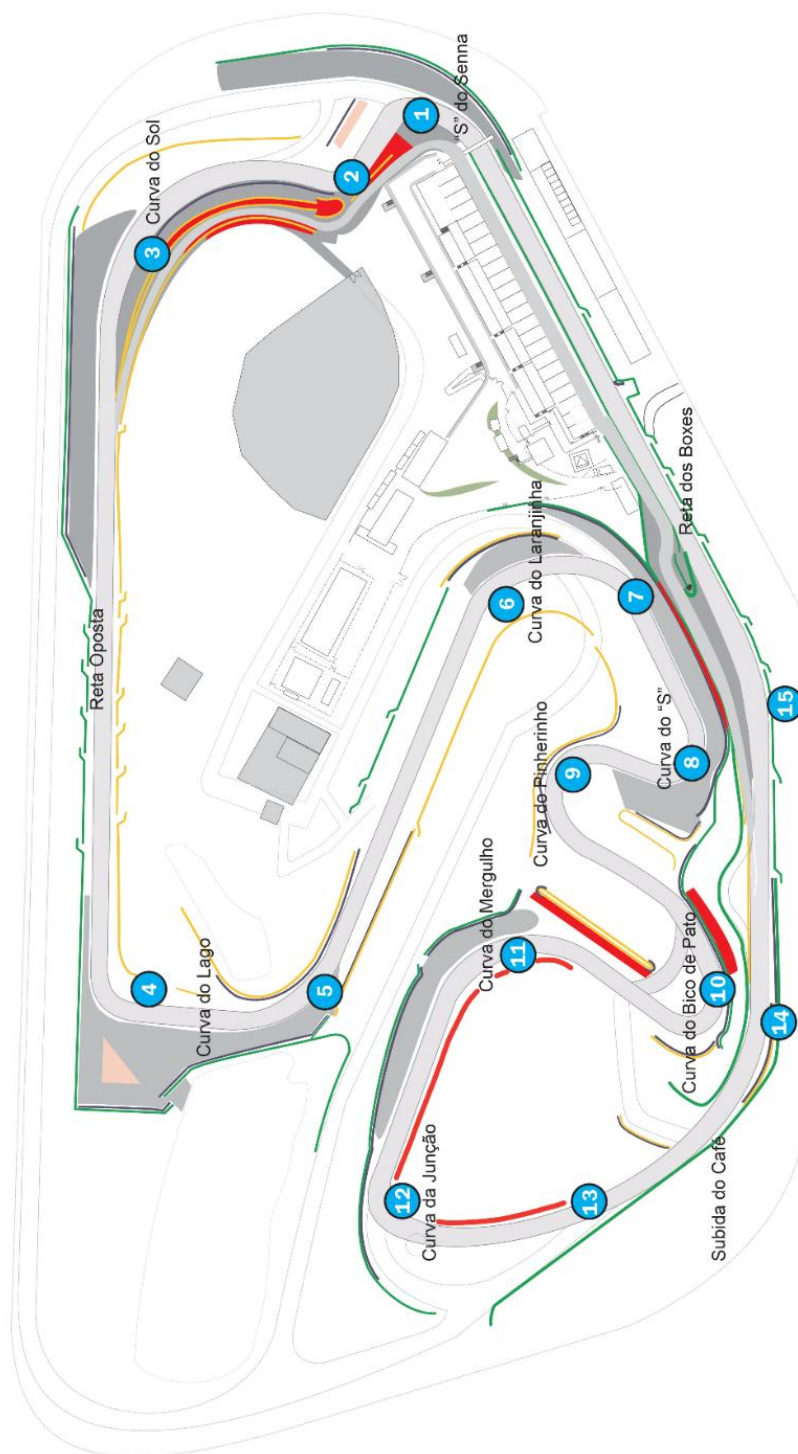


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RED ZONE MAP
