The following drivers will start the nineteenth Event of the 2017 Formula One World Championship with a new motor generator unit-heat (MGU-H):

The motor generator unit-heat used by Daniel Ricciardo is the eighth new motor generator unit-heat for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the MGU-H change on 06th November 2017, at 16:53 hours.

The motor generator unit-heat used by Brendon Hartley is the eighth new motor generator unit-heat for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the MGU-H change on 07th November 2017, at 09:06 hours.

The motor generator unit-heat used by Pierre Gasly is the eighth new motor generator unit-heat for the 2017 Championship season and as this is not in conformity with Article 23.3a of the 2017 Formula One Sporting Regulations, I am referring this matter to the stewards for their consideration. The team informed the technical delegate about the MGU-H change on 07th November 2017, at 20:19 hours.
