The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, summoned (documents 44 & 45) the drivers and team representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Session Race

Fact Causing an alleged collision with car 2 in turn 2.

Offence Involved in an alleged incident as defined by Article 38.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action

Reason The Stewards examined video evidence and heard from Kevin Magnussen, the driver of car 20, Stoffel Vandoorne, the driver of car 2 and the team representatives.

At the exit of turn 2 cars number 3, 2 and 20 were almost side by side. Car 20 moved to the left hand side of the track and made contact with car 2 and caused a chain reaction. Cars 2 and 20 had to retire as a result of the action.

The stewards concluded that no driver was wholly or predominantly to blame for the incident.
