Facts Electronic return of tyres was later than two hours after the end of P2.

Offence Breach of Article 24.4 g) iii) of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations.

Decision The competitor (Haas F1 Team) is fined €5,000 (suspended)

Reason The Stewards heard from the team representatives, who agreed that their tyres

were not turned in electronically within the required two hours. The team assured the Stewards that they have put new systems in place to ensure that this will not

recur.

The Stewards found that a breach of the regulations was committed and ordered a €5,000 fine which will be suspended during the remainder of the 2017 season

pending compliance with the relevant regulation.
