Appeal lodged by the Deutscher Motor Sport Bund (DMSB) on behalf of its licence-holder, Freisinger Motorsport, against Decision N°16 taken by the Panel of the Stewards on 20 April 2002 in the event run at Nevers Magny-Cours (France) on 19-21 April 2002 counting in the 2002 FIA GT Championship

Hearing of Tuesday, 9 July 2002 in Paris

The FIA INTERNATIONAL COURT OF APPEAL, comprising Mr Reginald REDMOND (Ireland), elected President, Mr Erich SEDELMAYER (Austria), and Mr Vassilis KOUSSIS (Greece),

Sitting in Paris, on Tuesday, 9 July 2002, at the Headquarters of the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA-France), 8 place de la Concorde, 75008 Paris,

**WHEREAS** the Deutscher Motor Sport Bund (DMSB), appellant on behalf of its competitor, Freisinger Motorsport, has announced the withdrawal of its appeal lodged against Decision N°16 of 20 April 2002 taken by the Panel of the Stewards of the Meeting in the event run at Nevers Magny-Cours from 19 to 21 April 2002,

**WHEREAS** the FIA representative does not oppose the International Court of Appeal's accepting the withdrawal of the appeal, as the appeal was not lodged in a dilatory manner with a view to allowing, because of its suspensive nature, the competitor's participation in the event.

### ON THESE GROUNDS,

**NOTES** the withdrawal by the Deutscher Motor Sport Bund (DMSB) on behalf of its competitor, Freisinger Motorsport, and gives official acknowledgement thereof,

**STATES** that the appeal fee belonging to the appellant shall be retained in its entirety, in accordance with Article 185.2 of the International Sporting Code,

**SENTENCES** the appellant to pay all costs as necessary.
