ABOUT LUSAIL INTERNATIONAL CIRCUIT



Lusail International Circuit (LIC) is Qatar's premier motorsport and entertainment destination, featuring a world-class FIA Grade 1 and FIM Grade A circuit, bespoke hospitality lounges, and state-of-the-art facilities to host international, regional, and community events.

Since opening in 2004, LIC has been the home of MotoGP™, staging the first-ever full night race in the championship and remaining the only circuit on the calendar to do so. In 2021, it welcomed Formula 1® with the inaugural Qatar Grand Prix and secured a ten-year agreement to host the race through 2032. Following an extensive upgrade completed in 2023, LIC now features the Guinness World Record for the world's longest motorsport pitlane building (402.1m), featuring 50 pit boxes – the largest of any Formula 1® circuit, expanded grandstands, premium hospitality, and new vantage points such as Lusail Hill at Turn 1.

In 2024, LIC expanded its portfolio further by debuting the FIA World Endurance Championship (WEC) season with the "Qatar 1812 KM" – a race named in honor of Qatar National Day. Under its agreement, Qatar will remain on the WEC calendar until at least 2029, making LIC one of only two circuits in the world to host all three pinnacle motorsport championships: Formula 1®, MotoGP™ and WEC.

Beyond global motorsport, Lusail International Circuit is deeply committed to the local community. The circuit regularly opens for public track days, giving enthusiasts a chance to experience the venue first-hand. It also hosts mixed training days for cycling and running, encouraging fitness and overall well-being. Through these initiatives, LIC stands not only as a premier sporting landmark, but also as an active hub for healthy lifestyles and community engagement in Qatar.

As a flagship venue under the Qatar Motor & Motorcycle Federation (QMMF), Lusail International Circuit embodies Qatar's passion for motorsport, hospitality, and innovation, creating unforgettable experiences for fans and competitors from around the world.

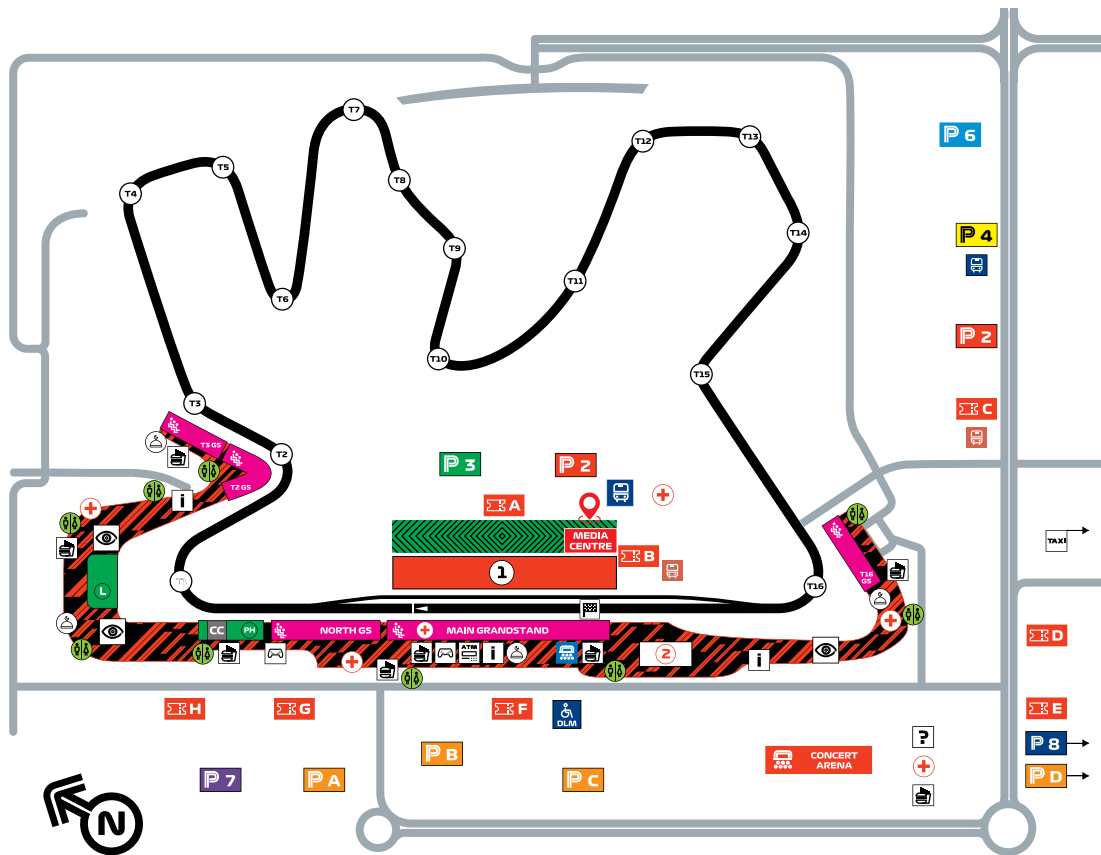

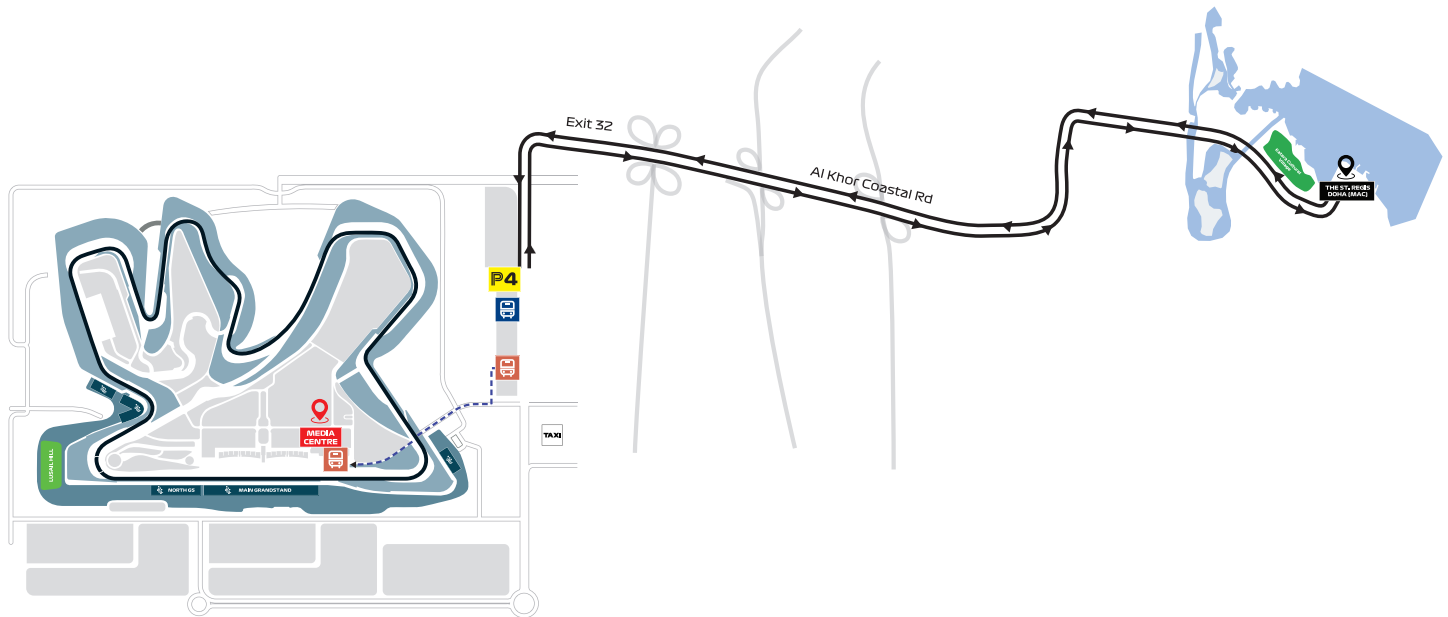

Alternative Transportation Methods:

We strongly recommend that all Media use the MAC shuttle service to arrive at the circuit.

However, should you choose to take a taxi, Karwa Taxi is the approved alternative transportation option. Karwa is Qatar's official metered taxi service—safe, reliable, and conveniently located. The Karwa drop-off point is located opposite the main gate, approximately a 7–5 minute walk to the Primary Security Area (PSA).

Please note that Uber may only be used for arrivals, as Uber services will not be available for departures.

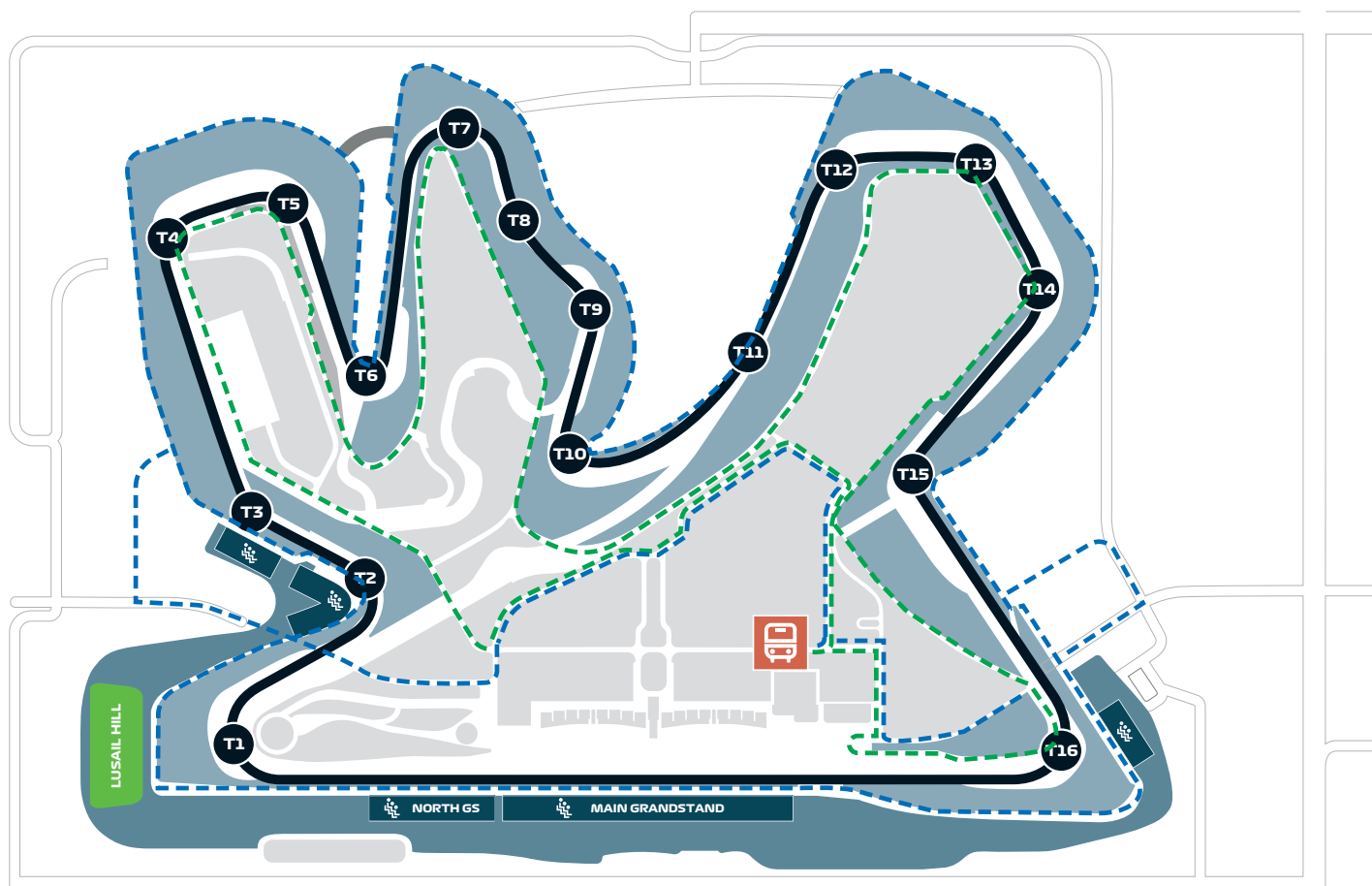

Photographers' Internal Shuttle Service Route

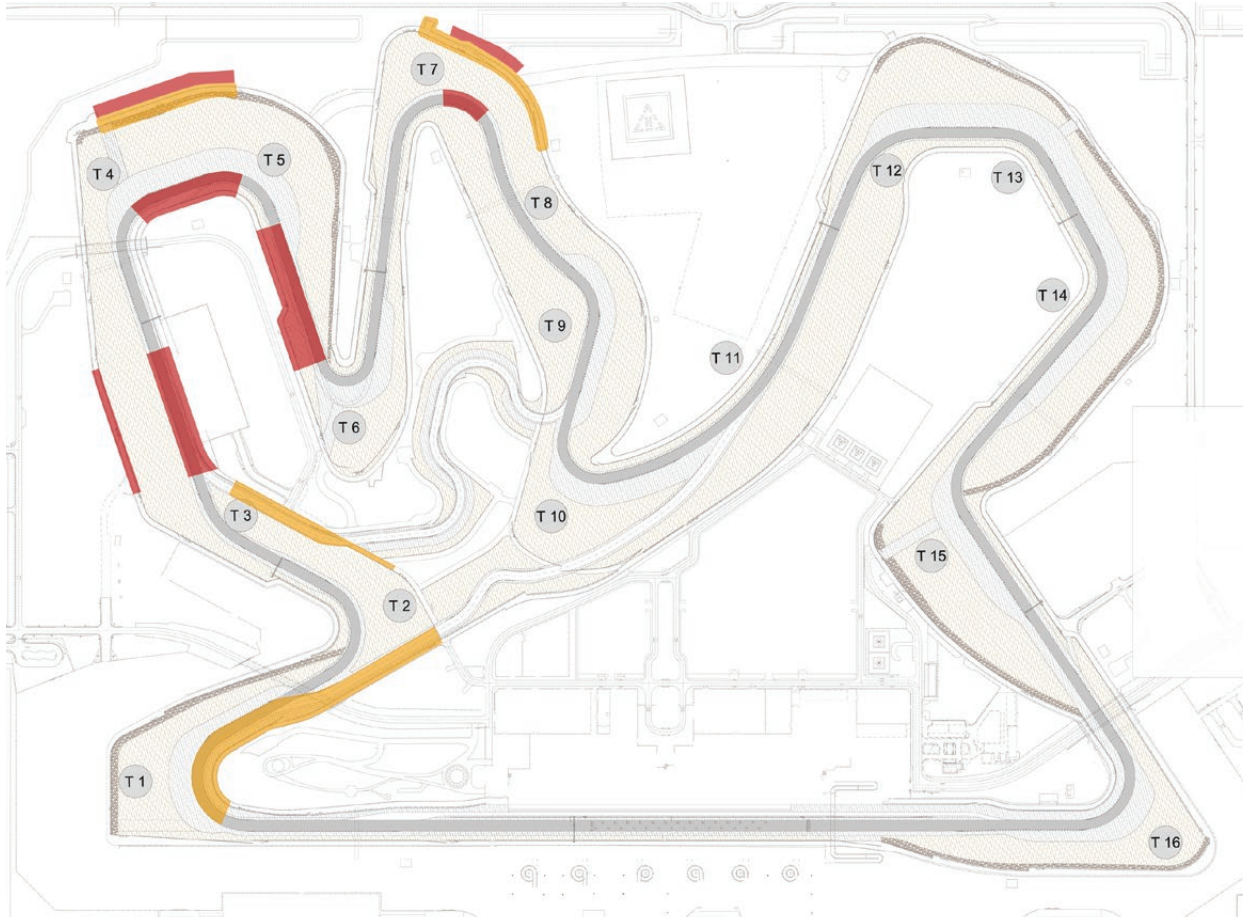


Photographers' External Shuttle Service Route

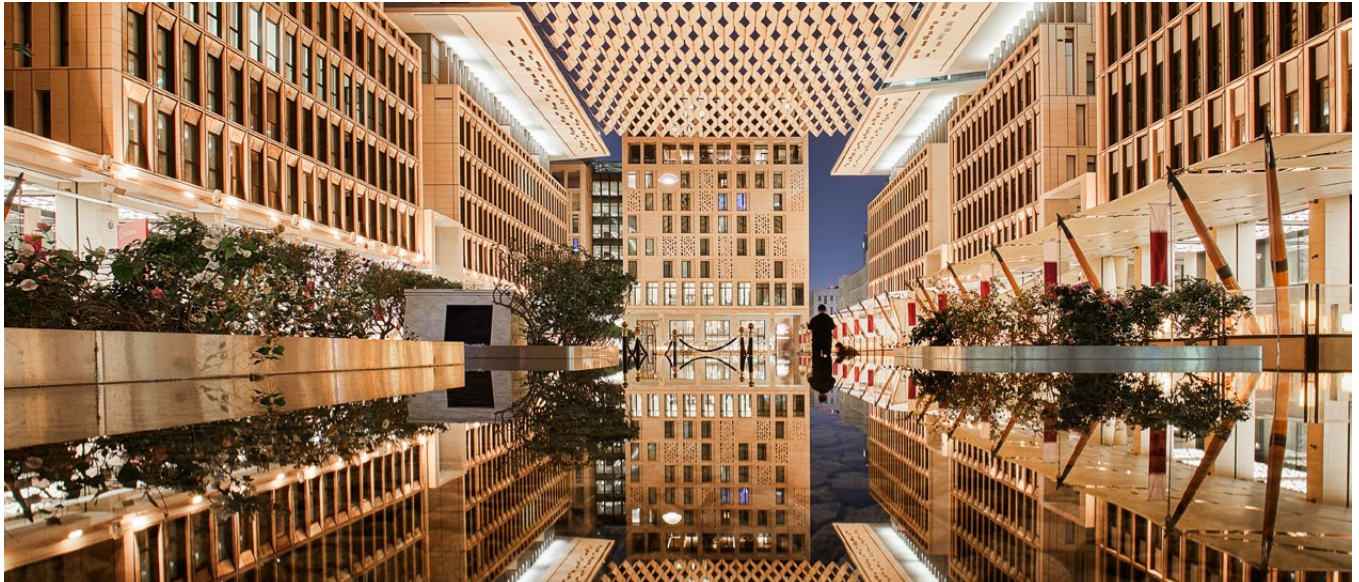
Old Doha Port - Mina District
