RED BULL RING – CIRCUIT DETAILS

The new Red Bull Ring complies with all current international safety standards. This means that every type of racing permitted under FIA (four-wheel) rules can be held there. Its length is 4.3 kilometers, and its routing is equal to the track used between 1996 and 2003, whose layout was designed by the world's most famous Grand Prix track architect Hermann Tilke.

Part of what makes this race track so attractive is the sloping terrain that surrounds it, creating a natural arena. Natural areas help solving the discrepancy between safety and the closeness of the spectators to the action in the best possible way. In the best spots, one practically sits above the race cars and can spot the drivers in their cockpits as they brake into and accelerate out of the corners, giving spectators the feeling of being part of the action; at most other tracks you are so far away you have to use binoculars. Certain places allow views of two thirds of the track, and it is not unusual to witness the now-rare spectacle of cars powersliding; the road surface lends itself to powersliding more than newly designed tracks. Since 2011, the Red Bull Ring has welcomed many major top-class racing series such as Formula 1, MotoGP, DTM and hosted many exciting races in various classes. The aim is to offer a balanced season programme with a mix of race events, presentations, testing and public activities.

SIX DECADES OF MOTORSPORT

At the Red Bull Ring, the smell of decades of exciting motorsport history lingers in the air. The Formula One races first took place at the Zeltweg airfield and then on what is now the Red Bull Ring. Jochen Rindt, Niki Lauda, Alain Prost, and Michael Schumacher all raced at top speed around this legendary track. The history of this famous circuit is characterised by several turning points.

ZELTWEG AIRFIELD

The race held in 1963 at the military airstrip in Zeltweg was given the title "First Grand Prix of Austria" but did not yet have world championship status. That changed in 1964, as the following race in Zeltweg did have world championship status.

ÖSTERREICHRING (1969–1995)

The opening of the Österreichring meant the end of the bumpy old Zeltweg airfield track, which the drivers had grown to hate. In 1970 it saw its first Formula 1 Grand Prix. What was exciting about that period was the contest to build Europe's fastest race track, faster than the Hockenheimring and Spa-Francorchamps. During the final Grand Prix in 1987 pole-sitter Nelson Piquet's time of 1:23.357 minutes around the 5.942 km track set an average speed record for the circuit of 256.621 km/h. Concerns about the Österreichring's safety had reached ahead in the mid-1990s, and it was completely rebuilt in 1995 and 1996.

A1 RING (1996–2003)

For safety reasons, the Österreichring was rebuilt by Hermann Tilke. Its length was reduced from 5.942 km to 4.326 km, and three narrow clockwise turns replaced fast and sharp turns to create space for overtaking. Seven Grand Prix races took place from that point onwards, some of which were fabulous, some of which patchy (team orders). 2003 saw the last Austrian Grand Prix on this track layout. After the end of the season, the diggers moved in to tear down part of the track.

RED BULL RING (2011–PRESENT)

Three years were spent on updating and upgrading Spielberg. On 15 May 2011, the time had finally come – Projekt Spielberg officially presented the new Red Bull Ring to the world of motorsport. In June, the DTM became the first major motorsport racing series to thrill tens of thousands of motorsport fans at the Red Bull Ring. The championship has returned to the circuit every year since then. In 2014, after eleven years, Formula 1 returned to Spielberg.



THE MURTAL: WHERE THE RACE WEEKEND BECOMES A REAL HOLIDAY

At Spielberg, Formula 1 is only the beginning. Around the Red Bull Ring – often described as one of the most beautiful race tracks in the world – the Murtal opens up into a holiday region made for long summer days, scenic detours and memorable discoveries beyond the grandstands.

Here, the energy of race weekends meets the calm of Styrian nature. One moment you are surrounded by the sound of engines and the excitement of the circuit; the next, you are cycling through gentle valleys, walking through fragrant Swiss stone pine forests or enjoying regional delicacies with mountain views. For visitors travelling to Spielberg for Formula 1, the Murtal offers the perfect reason to arrive early, stay longer and turn a motorsport trip into a full holiday experience.

A great way to explore the region is by bike. The Murtal's "Nimm's Radl" ("Take a bike") cycle path network makes route planning especially easy: cyclists simply follow numbered junctions and combine routes according to time, fitness level and mood. Leisure cyclists, e-bikers, gravel riders and road cyclists can all shape their own day out. Particularly fitting for race fans is the Red Bull Ring Loop, which leads through Seckau, Kobenz, Zeltweg and Fohnsdorf before returning to Spielberg.

Those who prefer to explore on foot will find just as much variety. The Murtal is a region of gentle walks, rewarding alpine hikes and panoramic mountain routes. In the Styrian "Zirbenland", trails lead through forests of Swiss stone pine – known locally as "Zirbe" – whose distinctive scent is part of the region's character. With numerous peaks above 2,000 meters, the area offers everything from leisurely nature walks to more challenging days in the mountains. After the intensity of the race track, this is where visitors can slow down, breathe deeply and enjoy the quieter side of Spielberg's surroundings.

The region also rewards curious travellers with culture, history and technology. Attractions such as the Strettweg Cult Wagon, the Oberzeiring Show Mine, the Military Aviation Museum and the Puch and VW Beetle museums showcase the Murtal's rich heritage and engineering traditions.

Families will also find plenty to enjoy. Playworld Spielberg, Austria's largest indoor family park, offers entertainment whatever the weather, while mini golf courses, the Fairy-Tale Forest in St. Georgen and the Knittelfeld Railway Museum add variety for younger visitors. For relaxation, AQUALUX Thermal Spa Fohnsdorf provides wellness and time to unwind.

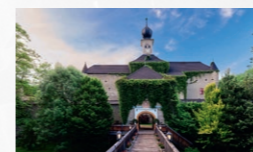
What makes the Murtal special is the ease with which it combines contrasts: fast and peaceful, sporty and indulgent, family-friendly and rich in culture. A day can begin with the roar of Formula 1 engines, continue with a bike ride along the Mur and end with dinner in a traditional Styrian inn.

For international visitors, Spielberg is more than a destination for a race weekend. It is the gateway to a region that invites discovery at every pace.

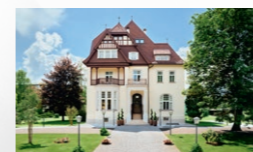
HOFWIRT

SCHÖNBERGHOF SPIELBERG

Located directly at the Red Bull Ring, Schönberghof Spielberg holds a rare position. The restaurant, panoramic terrace, TAURUS Bar and around 80 percent of the rooms offer direct views of the circuit, keeping the race present throughout the house. Contemporary interiors and relaxed Styrian cuisine balance the energy of the track with a composed sense of hospitality.



STEIRERSCHLÖSSL

Discreet and personal in character, Steirerschlössl is defined by calm and culinary precision. Within refined Art Nouveau surroundings, its Guide Michelin listed cuisine becomes a quiet expression, confident and grounded in quality. A place for focused conversations and considered enjoyment, shaped by atmosphere rather than occasion.



WASSTERTURM

Open, accessible and contemporary, Wasserturm is a natural meeting place. A café at ground level sets an easy daytime rhythm, while above, the panoramic bar opens wide views into the evening. Uncomplicated and attentive, it remains closely connected to everyday life in the Murtal.

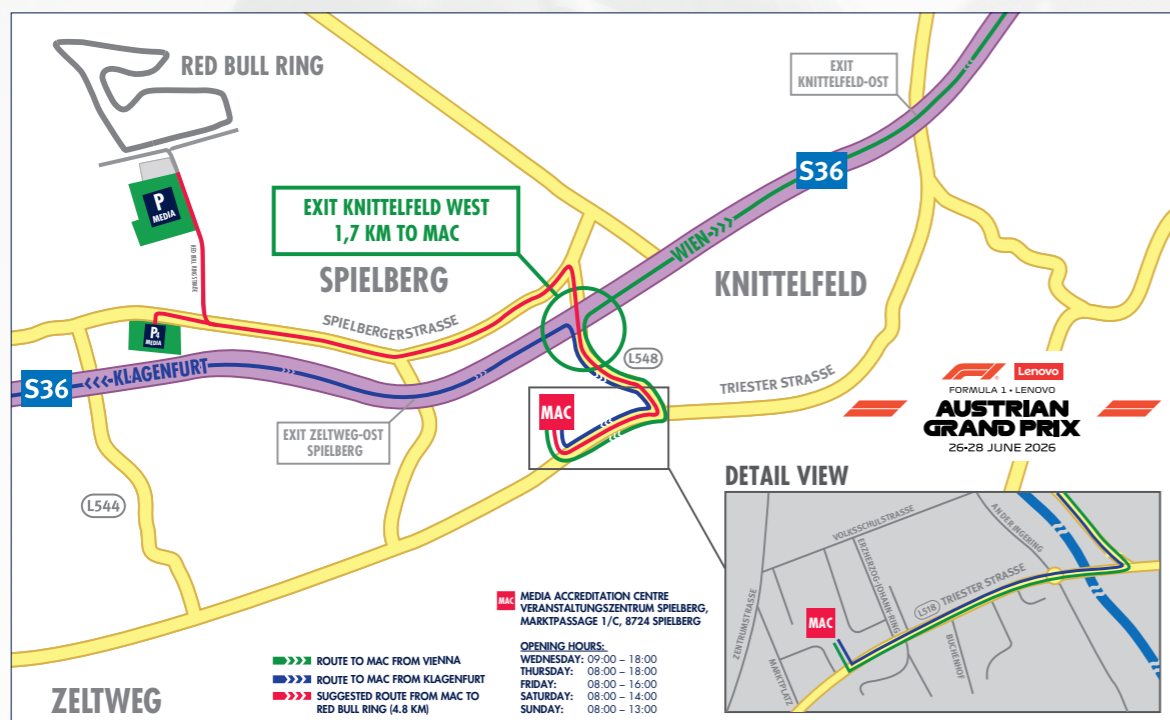

OPERA STAR TO SING NATIONAL ANTHEM AHEAD OF F1 GRAND PRIX AT RED BULL RING

The drivers contesting this year's Austrian Grand Prix will line up on the start-finish straight behind internationally acclaimed star tenor Jonas Kaufmann as he sings the Austrian national anthem – Land der Berge – accompanied by the talented East Tyrolean ensemble Musicbanda Franui.

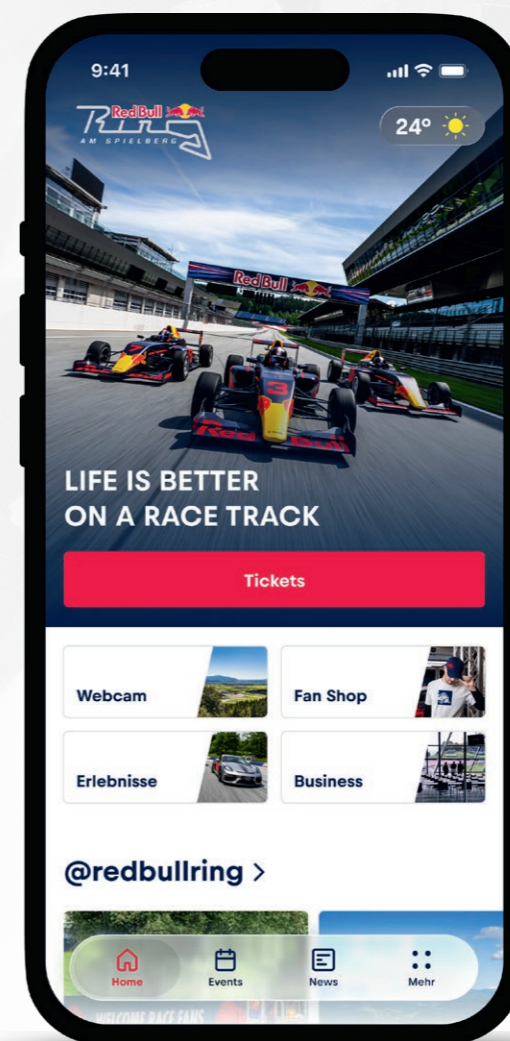
An extraordinary musical moment before the start of the Grand Prix: The musical prelude to Austria's biggest sporting event of 2026 spans an intercultural arc across the Alpine region, with Italian, French and German influences reaching right into the heart of Styria province.

German-Austrian opera star at Spielberg: Having performed at all the world's major opera houses and concert halls, Munich-born Jonas Kaufmann is one of the world's most sought-after singers. Kaufmann masters the entire tenor range of German, Italian and French opera repertoire, of oratorios, operettas and movie scores. During the current season, his major roles have included the painter Mario Cavaradossi in Puccini's 'Tosca' in Zurich and Paris. In early 2026, he made his stage debut at the Vienna State Opera as Eisenstein in Johann Strauss' 'Die Fledermaus'. The German-born who made Austria his home has been living in Salzburg since 2022 and has been artistic director of the Tyrolean Festival Erl since 2024.

East Tyrolean ensemble set to make big impression on world stage: Hailing from the small East Tyrolean village of Innervillgraten, the ten-piece Musicbanda Franui has been performing for 33 years with a virtually unchanged line-up at venues throughout Europe, including the Berlin State Opera, the Salzburg Festival and the Philharmonie de Paris. The ensemble has gained international renown for its reinterpretations of classical music and is not afraid to break down the boundaries between interpretation, improvisation and composition. On the Grand Prix weekend, the musicians will be employing their unique Austrian charm to blend Beethoven's 9th Symphony with the national anthem and the 'World Voice' of Jonas Kaufmann.

ICONIC F1 CARS IN RED BULL LEGENDS PARADE TO WOW FANS AT AUSTRIAN GP

The 2026 Austrian Grand Prix will feature an extra item on the programme: GP ICONS brings racing cars that made Formula 1 history during the period 1975 - 2010 back to the track, immersing Spielberg in an atmosphere of motorsport nostalgia. The cars in the Red Bull Legends Parade will be driven by some of the biggest names to have competed in the highest echelon of the sport. Emotional moments will be provided by Rubens Barrichello in the legendary Ferrari F2002 and by Mathias Lauda, who will be driving his father Niki's world championship-winning car.

RUBENS BARRICHELLO IN MICHAEL SCHUMACHER'S FERRARI:

The Austrian Formula 1 Grand Prix has produced a wealth of famous anecdotes. One of the best known concerns the team orders controversy involving Scuderia Ferrari in 2001 and in 2002 when Rubens Barrichello was told over the team radio to cede victory to eventual world champion Michael Schumacher. Now, in a conciliatory gesture to the past, the Brazilian will take the wheel of the championship-winning Ferrari F2002. Fans of the premier class will get goose bumps just thinking about moments such as these.

WHEN THE SON TAKES TO THE TRACK IN HIS FATHER'S CAR...

It can be no less spine-tingling. In this case, much to the delight of the fans, Mathias Lauda will be driving the Ferrari 312T in which Niki Lauda celebrated his first world championship title in 1975 and won the eternal gratitude of everyone at Maranello by securing the Constructors' championship.

MAXIMUM DOWNFORCE FOR MAIDEN TITLE:

The RB6 designed and built by Red Bull Racing is another car that delivered an incredible run of success. Sebastian Vettel secured his first championship title driving it in 2010 and, together with Mark Webber, the outfit's first Constructors' title. David Coulthard has the honour of firing up the Austrian team's sixth racing car once again. Designer Adrian Newey still raves about the RB6 today as one of the cars that generated more downforce than almost any other in F1 history.

LEGENDARY EYE-CATCHERS AT SPIELBERG:

Also sure to turn heads are the six-wheeled Tyrrell P34 and P34B from 1976 and 1977, which presented not only drivers but also tyre manufacturers of the time with a major challenge. The notorious 'Brabham Vacuum Cleaner' became a cult classic, in which Niki Lauda secured a commanding victory in just a single race in 1978. The car, with its controversial rear fan, was eventually withdrawn by then-team boss Bernie Ecclestone following protests. These and numerous other memorable events surrounding ten cars and icons of that era are what make the Red Bull Legends Parade the emotional highlight of the Austrian Grand Prix.
