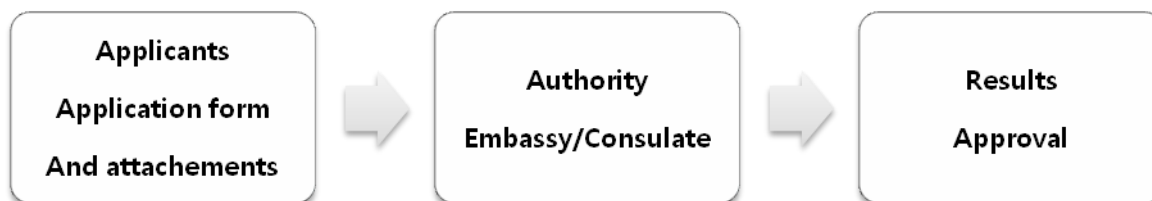
Guidance for Visa Issuance

1. Visa Policy

As with any other country, arrival in Korea is strictly regulated and the media who want to visit Korea to cover 2013 F1 Korean Grand Prix should apply for the C-1 visa category.

C-1 visa allows the media to stay for up to 90 days in Korea.

2. Visa Issuing Process



3. Documents to Submit

- Application form, passport, photo (35x45mm)
- One of the followings : Proof of employment / Proof of dispatch / ID of Journalist or Broadcasters / Accreditation Certificate for 2013 Korean Grand Prix.

4. Place to Visit

Korean Embassy / Consulate offices in country where you live. For countries with no Korean Embassy/Consulate offices, it is advisable to contact the Korean Embassies/Consulate offices in nearby countries
