Subject: FIA Standard 8863-2016 Safety Harnesses

Dear Sir or Madam.

We hereby inform you that the FIA has published an update of FIA Standard 8853-2016 Safety Harnesses, which can be found on the **FIA website**.

The updates include:

- Implementing a pre-conditioning test for webbing to prevent the use of exotic materials in high-end products. This test will be also required for webbing below a specified density, even if it is made of 100% polyester.
- Updating the opening torque requirements for the buckle to prevent accidental openings during racing; the buckle will also be tested without load on the straps following the sled test.
- Revising the buckle opening test procedure, based on a Round Robin Exercise, to ensure coaxial alignment between the lever and measuring system, thereby reducing measurement discrepancies across laboratories.
