RED BULL RING – CIRCUIT DETAILS

The new Red Bull Ring complies with all current international safety standards. This means that every type of racing permitted under FIA (four-wheel) rules can be held there. Its length is 4.3 kilometers, and its routing is equal to the track used between 1996 and 2003, whose layout was designed by the world's most famous Grand Prix track architect Hermann Tilke.

Part of what makes this race track so attractive is the sloping terrain that surrounds it, creating a natural arena. Natural areas help solving the discrepancy between safety and the closeness of the spectators to the action in the best possible way. In the best spots, one practically sits above the race cars and can spot the drivers in their cockpits as they brake into and accelerate out of the corners, giving spectators the feeling of being part of the action; at most other tracks you are so far away you have to use binoculars. Certain places allow views of two thirds of the track, and it is not unusual to witness the now-rare spectacle of cars powersliding; the road surface lends itself to powersliding more than newly designed tracks. Since 2011, the Ring has welcomed many major top-class racing series such as Formula 1, MotoGP, DTM and hosted many exciting races in various classes. The aim is to offer a balanced season programme with a mix of race events, presentations, testing and public activities.

SIX DECADES OF MOTORSPORT

At the Red Bull Ring, the smell of decades of exciting motorsport history lingers in the air. The Formula One races first took place at the Zeltweg airfield and then on what is now the Red Bull Ring. Jochen Rindt, Niki Lauda, Alain Prost, and Michael Schumacher all raced at top speed around this legendary track. The history of this famous circuit is characterised by several turning points.

ZELTWEG AIRFIELD

The race held in 1963 at the military airstrip in Zeltweg was given the title "First Grand Prix of Austria" but did not yet have world championship status. That changed in 1964, as the following race in Zeltweg did have world championship status.

ÖSTERREICHRING (1969–1995)

The opening of the Österreichring meant the end of the bumpy old Zeltweg airfield track, which the drivers had grown to hate. In 1970 it saw its first Formula 1 Grand Prix. What was exciting about that period was the contest to build Europe's fastest racetrack, faster than the Hockenheimring and Spa-Francorchamps. During the final Grand Prix in 1987 pole-sitter Nelson Piquet's time of 1:23.357 minutes around the 5.942 km track set an average speed record for the circuit of 256.621 km/h. Concerns about the Österreichring's safety had reached ahead in the mid-1990s, and it was completely rebuilt in 1995 and 1996.

A1 RING (1996–2003)

For safety reasons, the Österreichring was rebuilt by Hermann Tilke. Its length was reduced from 5.942 km to 4.326 km, and three narrow clockwise turns replaced fast and sharp turns to create space for overtaking. Seven Grand Prix races took place from that point onwards, some of which were fabulous, some of which patchy (team orders). 2003 saw the last Austrian Grand Prix on this track layout. After the end of the season, the diggers moved in to tear down part of the track.

RED BULL RING (2011–PRESENT)

Three years were spent on updating and upgrading Spielberg. On 15 May 2011, the time had finally come – Projekt Spielberg officially presented the new Red Bull Ring to the world of motorsport. In June, the DTM became the first major motorsport racing series to thrill tens of thousands of motorsport fans at the Red Bull Ring. The championship has returned to the circuit every year since then. In 2014, after eleven years, Formula 1 returned to Spielberg.

THE LEGENDS PARADE SHOWCASES THE INCREDIBLE CAN-AM ERA IN SPIELBERG

Following the celebrated return of the Legends Parade last year, 2023 will see six motorsport stars in veritable rockets of the Can-Am heyday take to the tarmac as a highlight of the Formula 1 side programme at the Red Bull Ring. McLaren, Lola and BRM are the familiar names behind the automotive treasures from an era that was virtually without limits and boasted unbridled power under the bonnet. The V8 giants of the iconic racing series will be driven by absolute masters of their craft: lining up at the start will be David Coulthard, Dr Helmut Marko, Juan Pablo Montoya, Jos Verstappen, Mark Webber and Alexander Wurz.

BIG BANGERS MAKE THE GROUND VIBRATE WITH THEIR V8 POWER

Catapulted onto the motorsport stage in 1966, the Canadian-American Challenge Cup saw numerous driving legends celebrate success, including Bruce McLaren, Phil Hill, John Surtees, Jack Brabham, Mario Andretti and Jackie Stewart. In comparison with what was one of the world's most spectacular racing series at the time, Formula 1 lagged behind in terms of performance and popularity. The difference was that there were almost no restrictions. There were no limits on engine size in the regulations, resulting in veritable rockets on four wheels with turbochargers or superchargers that propelled them into previously unknown speed dimensions. Hailed by fans as Big Bangers, which caused a downright earthquake on the tarmac, the legend of the Can-Am series represents limitless racing and a truly special era in motorsport history to this day.

SIX LEGENDS IN RACING CARS WITH WELL OVER 800 HP

Since 2014, fans in Spielberg have considered the eight Legends Parades as the absolute highlight of the supporting programme at the Formula 1 event in Austria. Featuring in the line-up of the most legendary racing cars in motorsport history are impressive eye-catchers from the heyday of the Can-Am series. They'll be on the grid at the Red Bull Ring on Saturday 01 July and Sunday 02 July. Throughout the Grand Prix weekend, the historic cars will be on display in the F1 Fan Zone, and fans will have the chance to take a look up close.

Juan Pablo Montoya will be taking to the wheel of a jewel in the Can-Am crown, the McLaren M8F. He will be accompanied by David Coulthard, Alexander Wurz and Jos Verstappen in the cockpits of other McLaren models. Breaking ranks will be Mark Webber in a Lola T165 and Dr Helmut Marko in a BRM 157. Renowned Swiss mechanic Edi Wyss can't help but grin: "The fact that Helmut Marko is now driving this car is so fitting considering he made his F1 debut in the BRM team. This car is chassis number 2 and was driven by Mexican Pedro Rodríguez in the Can-Am series in 1970. The P157 was the first Can-Am car from BRM, and was designed by legendary engineer Tony Southgate."

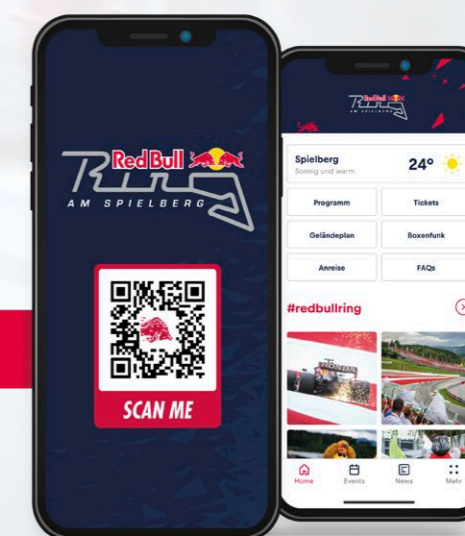
PODIUM-WORTHY SIDE EVENTS

KOLONOVITS REIMAGINES TWO ANTHEMS FOR A GRAND PRIX

The cultural and musical heritage of Austria is broadcast around the world each year on Formula 1 Grand Prix weekend when the country's national anthem receives a fresh interpretation. In 2023, 'Land der Berge' and the 'Dachsteinlied' will merge into a single sound experience, providing the goosebump moment of the event. The mastermind behind the new Red Bull Symphonic-style composition is Christian Kolonovits. He will be conducting the Graz Philharmonic Orchestra and the chamber choir of the Johann-Joseph-Fux Conservatory Graz in a performance by two of Austria's biggest vocal talents, Christopher Seiler (Seiler & Speer) and Juliette Khalil (Volksoper).

TWO CLASSIC MELODIES BLENDED INTO ONE

Thousands of motorsport fans, three musical geniuses, two anthems and an orchestra and a choir for each – the breath-taking backdrop for the 2023 Austrian Grand Prix at the Red Bull Ring has been prepared. Christian Kolonovits has succeeded in blending the official national anthem and the Dachsteinlied into a harmonious whole. "It was a musical challenge that I relished," says Kolonovits. "Having the opportunity to realise this vision with Red Bull is a privilege that gives me a considerable amount of satisfaction." He has already received many awards over the course of his career and is highly esteemed by international stars such as Plácido Domingo but performing the new arrangement and the premiere of the anthem in front of the packed grandstands at the Red Bull Ring is going to be a new emotional high for Kolonovits.

OPENING SHOW FEATURING MORE THAN 70 MUSICIANS

Backed by members of the Graz Philharmonic Orchestra and singers of the Johann-Joseph-Fux Conservatory chamber choir, Christopher Seiler and Juliette Khalil will be singing the new composition shortly before the start of Sunday's race. The creative trio of Christian Kolonovits, Juliette Khalil and Christopher Seiler have already performed together on stage at the Red Bull Symphonic 2022 at Vienna's Konzerthaus. "It is a great pleasure and honour for me to be singing at such a globally momentous event as the Austrian Grand Prix," says Christopher Seiler. "It will be a very special performance." As one half of the pop duo Seiler and Speer, Christopher is one of the biggest domestic music phenomena of recent years. The more than 70 musicians gathered on the front straight of the Red Bull Ring will not only generate a stadium-filling sound, but also bring Austrian musical heritage to an audience of millions all around the world.

AUSTROPOP MEETS CLASSICAL MUSIC

The extraordinary arrangement of the two anthems will be presented by Christopher Seiler in a duet with soprano Juliette Khalil. The opera star has been a permanent ensemble member at Vienna's Volksoper since 2015 and is internationally celebrated for her remarkable vocal range. "In this unique composition, Christian Kolonovits has once again demonstrated his exceptional musical talent," she says. "To be invited to appear here at the Red Bull Ring as a soloist and to share this reimagination of our national anthem with viewers around the world, is a very special opportunity for me, which makes me infinitely grateful."
