



## RACE STEWARDS BIOGRAPHIES



### **TIM MAYER**

#### **FIA STEWARD, ORGANISER OF THE FIA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN THE USA**

As the son of McLaren founder Teddy Mayer, Tim Mayer grew up around motor sport. He organised IndyCar races internationally from 1992-98 and produced international TV for multiple series. In 1998 he became CART's Senior VP for Racing Operations and in 2003 became COO of IMSA, operating multiple series, including ALMS. In 2009 he left IMSA, working independently for several US series and coordinating US motorsports with the FIA. He was elected an Independent Director of ACCUS and US FIA Delegate, responsible for World Championship events in the US. He Stewards the FIA's F1, WEC and World Rallycross championships.

### **SILVIA BELLOT**

#### **FIA WOMEN IN MOTORSPORT AMBASSADOR; FORMULA 1, FORMULA E, FORMULA 2 AND FORMULA 3 STEWARD**

Silvia Bellot began marshalling in 2001, when she was 16 and has been a steward in a number of international championships including: WRC, WTCC, F3 World Cup, GP2, GP3, DTM, Euro Formula and World Series. She made her first appearance as an F1 steward in 2011 and just a year later was awarded FIA Outstanding Official. In 2020 she became the first FIA female race director, being responsible for the FIA Formula 2 and Formula 3 Championships. She is currently an Ambassador of the FIA Women in Motorsport Commission, on which she represents the female volunteers and officials.



### **TOM KRISTENSEN**

#### **NINE TIMES LE MANS WINNER, GERMAN F3, JAPANESE F3, ALMS AND WEC CHAMPION, PRESIDENT OF THE FIA DRIVERS' COMMISSION, FIA WORLD MOTOR SPORT COUNCIL MEMBER**

Tom Kristensen's outstanding career saw him race in single-seaters, touring cars as well as testing for Formula 1. However, it is for his achievements in sportscars that the Dane is most lauded. The Dane is the most successful driver in the history of both the Le Mans 24-Hour race and the 12 Hours of Sebring, which he has won six times. In 2013 he also won the FIA World Endurance Championship title. Since retirement in 2014, he has been a regular driver steward in Formula 1.

### **IACOPO ARCANGELI**

#### **CHAIRMAN OF STEWARDS FOR THE ITALIAN F4 CHAMPIONSHIP, ITALIAN GT CHAMPIONSHIP, PORSCHE CARRERA CUP ITALY.**

Iacopo Arcangeli has been heavily involved in Italian motorsport for the last 15 years, working first as a scrutineer and then a steward for a variety of disciplines including circuit racing, rallies and hill climbs. He is a member of FIA International Stewards Programme and currently chairs the panel of stewards for the Italian Formula 4 Championship, the Italian GT Championship, the Porsche Carrera Cup Italy and the Formula Regional European Championship. He works in the automotive industry and holds a Masters' degree in Automotive Engineering from the Polytechnic University of Turin.
