## **APPLICABLE REGULATION**

**Article A7.6** ⊠ 2023 FIA World Endurance Championship Sporting Regulations

## **DECISION**

Following the WEC\_2023\_R01, the WEC Committee would like to clarify the following article:

a) The "signalling area" is clearly delimited, for each competitor car, on the pit wall.

The maximum dimensions of the installations are as follows:

- Height: 2.20 m above the level of the track;
- Width: 2.50 m along the signalling wall;
- Depth: 1.00 m from the pit wall on the pit side.
- b) The installations and their means of attachment must remain flush with the wall (on the track side).
- c) The only inscriptions authorised on these installations are the make of the car and/or the name of the team given on the Competitor's licence.
- d) The boards used for informing the drivers:
  - must be sliding or pivoting.
  - The background cannot be coloured (must be black, grey or white).
  - The colour of the lettering inside the board is at the teams' choice but it cannot flash.
  - The boards must be taken out and shown to the driver concerned only when the car is in the vicinity of the signalling area while driving past on the track.
- e) Sunshades, parasols and umbrellas are prohibited.
- f) Team members can only access the pit wall area that is allocated to their car.
- g) 3 people maximum per competitor car are authorised in the signalling area.
