

APPLICABLE REGULATION

Article 15.1.1 🛛 2023 FIA World Endurance Championship Sporting Regulations

DECISION

The WEC Committee would like to clarify the following article:

15.1.1 Finish procedure

Chequered flag: when the scheduled time for the race has elapsed or the full race distance has been covered, the chequered flag will be shown to the car that is leading the general classification when it crosses the finish line on the racetrack. If for any reason the chequered flag is shown late, the race will be deemed to have finished at the scheduled time.

When the chequered flag is shown, the pit exit will be closed.

After receiving the end-of-race signal, all cars must proceed on the circuit directly to the Parc Fermé without stopping and without any assistance (except that of the marshals, if necessary), under its own power. Team members must be available in the vicinity of the Parc Fermé in order to help the Scrutineers.

Penalty: possible disqualification of any car that does not proceed to the Parc Fermé as soon as possible.
