- F3 Cars will be pushed to the support pit lane at 14:50, teams will be located outside the following F2 garages:

- Trolleys will not be allowed in the pit lane, however front and rear jacks are permitted
- F3 Cars will access the track from the support pit lane and they will return to the F3 garages using the support pit lane only
- F3 Cars must comply with the 2026 F3 Sporting and Technical Regulations except for Art. 24.16 (Plank limitation) of the F3 Sporting Regulations. Unregistered Planks may be used during this session.
- F3 Cars will run with installation tyres only during this session
- F3 Drivers must activate the start setup procedure when the green light will be displayed at 15:00, activated throughout the entire Pit Lane until Pit Out.
- F3 Cars will then move to the fast lane to exit the pits
- All F3 Cars must be on track at the same time
- Each F3 car will be allowed to pass the finish line twice, complete a lap and return to the F3 paddock
- Any car entering the pits during the session will not be allowed to return on track
- During the sessions drivers must observe all flags and light panels displayed
