The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 14 - Martinius Stenshorne

Competitor Rodin Motorsport

Time 14:40

Session Race 1

Fact Car 14 (Stenshorne) overtook Car 6 (Tsolov) on the inside of Turn 2 by leaving the track and gained a lasting advantage.

Infringement Breach of Article 27.3 of the FIA Formula 2 Sporting Regulations and of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 (c) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision Five seconds (5) time penalty in accordance with Article 39.3 (a) of the FIA F2 Sporting Regulations. No driver penalty points are associated with this infringement.

Reason The Stewards reviewed available footage of the Incident.

Car 14 was overtaking Car 6 on the outside of Turn 1 but had not completed the overtake. Car 14 continued to fight for position. Between Turn 1 and Turn 2 Car 14 left the track and then re-entered the track at the exit of Turn 2 and gained a position over Car 6.

The Stewards find that mitigating circumstances exist to impose a 5 second Time Penalty on this occasion rather than the usual penalty of 10 seconds. The mitigating circumstances are that the driver of Car 14 attempted to redress and allow Car 6 ahead, however, because of Car 16's defensive manoeuvre, he had a slower exit from Turn 2 and became vulnerable to following cars and lost positions.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
