² In line with the World Anti-Doping Code and Appendix A to the FIA International Sporting Code, this table lists FIA license-holders who are currently serving periods of ineligibility following anti-doping rule violations under the FIA's results management authority. Sanctions imposed by other anti-doping organisations are automatically recognised and enforceable under the FIA Anti-Doping Rules, and may be included in that list. Individuals listed are prohibited, for the duration of their ineligibility, from participating in any role in events or activities (except approved anti-doping education or rehabilitation programmes) that are authorised, recognised, or organised by the FIA, its ASNs, any other Signatory to the Code or its member organisations, or any competitions run by professional leagues or organisers of international or national-level events.

³ Article 12.13 (effects of suspension) of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code:

"12.13.1 A sentence of Suspension pronounced by an ASN shall apply only within the territory of that ASN.

12.13.2 If, however, the ASN wishes the sentence of Suspension against any of its licence-holders (Competitors, Drivers, officials, Organisers, etc) to be recognised internationally, it shall notify its wish without delay to the Secretariat of the FIA and the latter will inform all other ASNs. The sentence of Suspension shall be noted by each ASN immediately, and the consequent restriction will thereby come into force.

⁴ **Article 12.14 (exclusion) of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code:**

"12.14.1 Except in the cases provided for in the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, a sentence of Exclusion can be pronounced only by an ASN and will be reserved for offences of exceptional gravity.

12.14.2 A sentence of Exclusion shall always be international in nature. It shall be notified to all the ASNs and be registered by them according to the conditions of international Suspension."
